

FALL CENTERPIECE

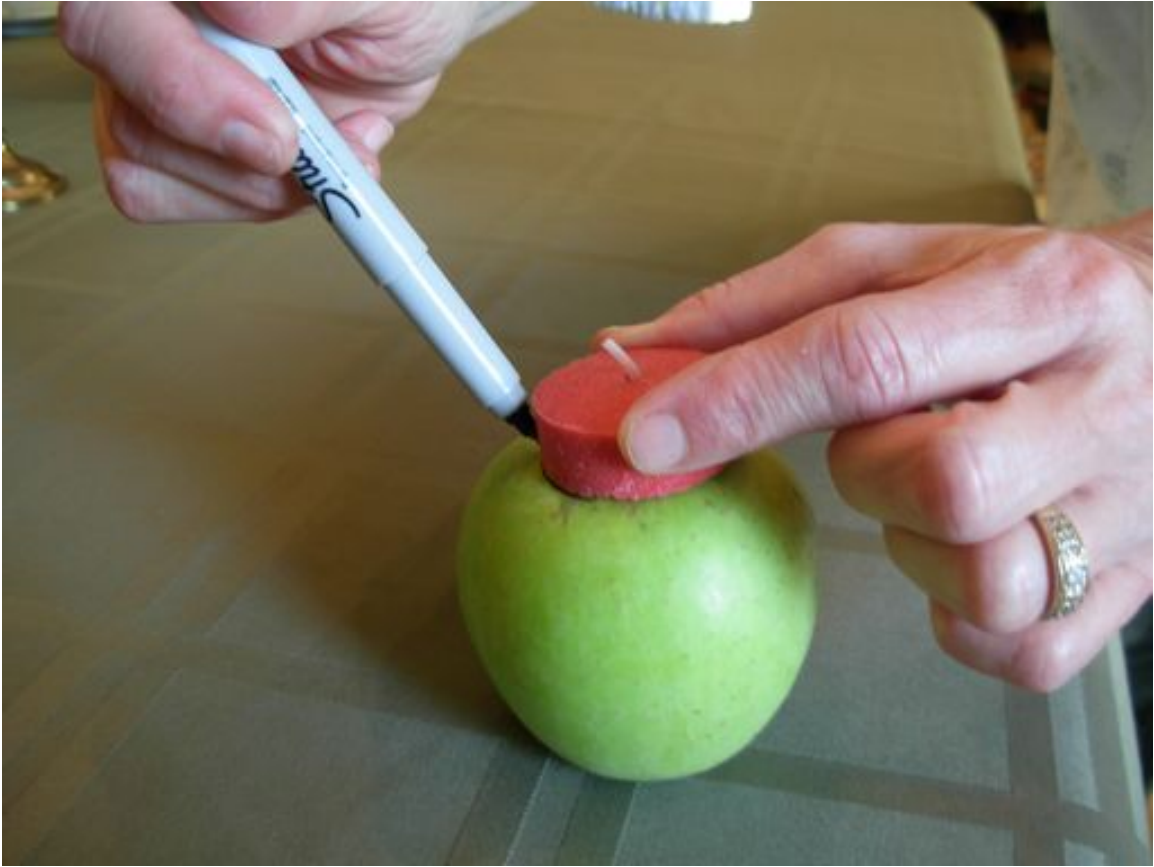

1. Collect your materials:

- the plate or platter of your choice--I used narrow a rectangular platter and a small dessert-sized plate
- green and red apples--similar size and shape, with flat enough bottoms so that they can stand upright--enough to fill the plate you choose.
- 1 tea light candle for each apple
- small Autumn napkin rings or candle-wreaths to place under apples (I got mine at K-Mart but probably many craft stores would have something comparable.)
- pretty leaves from your yard (optional)
- knife
- Sharpie or pen



2. Remove stem from each apple. Trace a tea light candle on the top of the apple.



3. Using knife, cut the traced section out of the apple, cutting about 1 inch deep.



4. Press tea light candle inside apple.



5. Place apple(s) over small wreath. Arrange on plate or platter of your choice and light candles.



6. For added interest, arrange pretty leaves under the plate or platter. Voila, your easy centerpiece is complete!
