



**FALL FLOWER ARRANGEMENT**

Supplies:

- Square vase or candle holder med. to large size
- small jar to fit inside the square vase (a larger size baby food jar works well or if your square vase was big enough, a 1/2 pint canning jar would work well too.)
- Candy Corn
- 5 Mums
- 3-5 sprigs of artificial eucalyptus
- Small bundle of preserved oak leaves (or other fall leaves)

Directions:

\*Place the jar inside the square vase and fill the space in between with candy corn. Add a little water to the jar (1/2 way up) and insert one Mum on each side, cutting the Mum so it sits just above the rim of the square vase. Place one Mum in the center, cutting the stem so that this Mum sits above the other four.

\*Place 3-5 of the eucalyptus branches into the candy corn all around the arrangement. Bend the stems down a bit so that some of them go below the top of the vase. Fill in any other space with the preserved leaves.

\*To water the arrangement use an eye dropper or a turkey baster so you are able to place the water directly into the jar of flowers. The candy corn will melt a bit if you get it wet. Use as a center piece or mantle decoration. Surround with little pumpkins if you like! The Mums will last several weeks.
